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According to the Decision on the Recognition of Professorial and Associate Professorial Standards for 2025 issued by the State Council for Professorship on November 19, 2025, Can Tho University had a total of 22 distinguished educators officially recognized as meeting the standards, including 03 Professors and 19 Associate Professors. This recognition marked a significant milestone for Can Tho University in 2025, affirming its pioneering role in higher education, scientific research, and innovation in the Mekong Delta and across Vietnam.



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03 New Professors and 19 Associate Professors of Can Tho University Recognized by the State Council for Professorship

The 22 distinguished educators recognized as meeting the standards for the titles of Professor and Associate Professor came from 10 affiliated units of Can Tho University. Among them, the College of Agriculture had 05 lecturers recognized; the College of Engineering, 04 lecturers; the Institute of Food and Biotechnology, 03 lecturers; the College of Natural Sciences, 03 lecturers; and the College of Information and Communication Technology, 02 lecturers. The remaining units, each with 01 lecturer recognized, included the School of Foreign Languages, the School of Economics, Hau Giang Campus, the School of Political Science, Social Sciences and Humanities, and the College of Aquaculture and Fisheries. As of November 2025, Can Tho University had a total of 220 recognized Professors and Associate Professors, including 26 Professors and 194 Associate Professors.



The continued growth in both the number and quality of Professors and Associate Professors not only reflected individual academic excellence, but also underscored the University's mission to nurture talented individuals in a liberal learning environment, foster cutting-edge research, and drive technology transfer. This achievement further highlighted Can Tho University's commitment to building a prosperous and sustainable society in the era of globalization and the Fourth Industrial Revolution.



Can Tho University Upgrades the College of Natural Sciences as a Specialized University

Within the framework of the Ceremony commemorating the 43rd Anniversary of Vietnamese Teachers' Day (November 20, 1982 – November 20, 2025), Can Tho University officially announced Resolution No. 89/NQ-HĐT dated November 17, 2025, issued by the Board of Trustees, approving the upgrade of the College of Natural Sciences from a faculty-level academic unit to a specialized university within Can Tho University.



The establishment of the College of Natural Sciences in a specialized university marked an important milestone, not only commemorating nearly 30 years since its re-establishment and continuous development, but also reflecting the collective dedication and achievements of generations of leaders, lecturers, staff, and students. More importantly, this transition reaffirmed Can Tho University's strategic orientation toward strengthening fundamental scientific research, building a solid foundation for advanced and interdisciplinary research, fostering emerging technologies, and generating research outcomes with high practical value to support the sustainable development of the region.

At present, Can Tho University comprises seven specialized universities, including the College of Engineering, the College of Information and Communication Technology, the School of Economics, the College of Agriculture, the School of Education, the College of Aquaculture and Fisheries, and the College of Natural Sciences, together with five Faculties and two Institutes. This organizational structure further affirms Can Tho University's position as one of Vietnam's leading centers of higher education and scientific research, steadily advancing toward regional and international integration while making meaningful contributions to knowledge creation, innovation, and the country's sustainable development.

Nearly 6,000 New Graduates Awarded Degrees at the Second Graduation Ceremony for Full-Time Undergraduate Programs in 2025

From October 3 to October 13, 2025, Can Tho University solemnly held the second graduation ceremony for full-time undergraduate programs in 2025, conferring degrees upon nearly 6,000 new bachelors and engineers from 13 academic units.

The graduates came from the following units: College of Engineering; College of Aquaculture and Fisheries; School of Economics; School of Education; College of Agriculture; College of Information and Communication Technology; Hau Giang Campus; School of Political Science, Social Sciences and Humanities; Institute of Food and Biotechnology; School of Foreign Languages; College of Environment and Natural Resources; College of Natural Sciences; and School of Law.

More than 400 Graduates Awarded Degrees at the Second Graduation Ceremony for Part-Time and Distance Learning Undergraduate Programs in 2025

On November 23, 2025, Can Tho University awarded degrees to more than 400 new engineers and bachelor's graduates from part-time undergraduate and distance learning undergraduate programs at the second graduation ceremony in 2025. These graduates were outstanding learners from the 2021, 2022, and 2023 cohorts.

Alongside full-time undergraduate programs, Can Tho University has proactively and effectively implemented part-time undergraduate, distance learning undergraduate, and short-term training programs to enhance qualifications and update knowledge for diverse learner groups. Training collaborations with domestic and regional partners have yielded practical outcomes, expanding access to higher education and contributing significantly to the development of a high-quality workforce serving the country's industrialization and modernization process.



The Second Graduation Ceremony for Postgraduate Programs in 2025: Affirming Sustainable Value in Graduate Education and Research

On December 27, 2025, Can Tho University solemnly held the second graduation ceremony for doctoral and master's programs in 2025, awarding degrees to 15 new PhDs and 468 new master's degree graduates who met all graduation requirements. The ceremony took place in a solemn, warm, and meaningful atmosphere at Turtle Hall, marking an important milestone in the academic journeys of doctoral candidates and graduate students.

Currently, Can Tho University's postgraduate enrollment totals 3,576 learners, including 382 doctoral candidates and 3,194 master's students. In 2025 alone, Can Tho University admitted 1,187 master's students and 121 doctoral candidates. During the ceremony, the University conferred 15 doctoral degrees and 468 master's degrees. To date, Can Tho University has awarded degrees to a total of 412 PhDs and 15,225 master's degree graduates.

Anticipating Emerging Trends – Can Tho University Advances the Development of Key Academic Programmes



In the fourth quarter of 2025, Can Tho University implemented a strategic plan to develop and prepare for the opening of 12 new academic programmes at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. These programmes span a wide range of fields, including social sciences and humanities, STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics), biotechnology and modern agriculture, as well as industry and infrastructure. This initiative reflects the University's strong determination to innovate and its proactive approach to anticipating emerging trends in science and technology, digital transformation, industrialization, modernization, and sustainable development.

The planned programmes have been developed through extensive consultations with relevant stakeholders, ensuring close alignment between academic foundations, practical application, and societal needs. With a focus on nurturing high-quality human resources possessing adaptability and global integration capacity, this effort further affirms Can Tho University's pioneering role within Vietnam's higher education system and its mission to serve the sustainable development of the Mekong Delta and the nation in the new development phase.



Anticipating Emerging Trends – Can Tho University Advances the Development of Key Academic Programmes

Can Tho University plans to open a Doctoral programme in Vietnamese Literature and a Master's programme in Literature, marking an important step in the training and research strategy of the School of Political Science, Social Sciences and Humanities. These programmes are being developed with a modern orientation, emphasizing advanced research capacity, critical thinking, and academic rigor, while fostering strong linkages between literary theory and contemporary social realities.

Through expert consultation workshops involving scholars, employers, and learners, the curricula have been refined toward openness, flexibility, and alignment with international academic standards. The programmes are expected to contribute to the development of lecturers, researchers, and literary scholars capable of international integration and meaningful contributions to the sustainable development of Vietnamese culture and human values.

Advancing Social Sciences and Humanities with Depth and Global Integration



Expanding STEM Programmes to Meet Digital Transformation Demands

In line with its strategy to expand STEM education, Can Tho University is developing an undergraduate programme in Data Science (under the College of Natural Sciences) and a Talent Engineer programme in Semiconductor Integrated Circuit Design (under the College of Engineering). These fields respond to the growing demand for highly skilled human resources in the digital economy and reflect global shifts in technological investment and innovation.

The programmes are being designed with the active participation of management agencies, enterprises, and subject-matter experts to ensure strong practical relevance, enhanced application-oriented learning, and increased research and innovation capacity for learners. This initiative demonstrates the University's commitment to positioning itself at the forefront of emerging technological domains while expanding academic and career opportunities for students.



Investing in Biotechnology and Modern Agriculture Education

Building upon its long-standing strengths, Can Tho University is preparing to implement a Talent Master's Programme in Biotechnology (under the Institute of Food and Biotechnology) and develop a high-quality undergraduate programme in Plant Protection (under the College of Agriculture). These programmes aim to train experts with solid academic foundations, advanced experimental skills, and strong international integration capacity, meeting the demands of high-tech, green, and sustainable agricultural development.

Investments in key laboratories, combined with a training approach closely linked to scientific research and real-world production, are regarded as critical foundations for enhancing education quality and supplying high-caliber human resources for both the region and the country.



Strengthening Engineering, Industry, and Infrastructure Training

Can Tho University continues to develop new programmes in the fields of engineering, industry, and infrastructure, including a Doctoral programme in Chemical Engineering, high-quality undergraduate programmes in Mechanical Engineering and Construction Management, and a specialization in High-Speed Railway Engineering. Developed under the College of Engineering, these programmes emphasize hands-on practice, research, technology transfer, and close collaboration with industry partners, responding to the requirements of industrialization, modernization, and sustainable infrastructure development.

Through consultation workshops with stakeholders, the University has refined these programmes on sound scientific and practical foundations, paving the way for future implementation and contributing to the training of engineers and technical experts capable of leadership and adaptability in a rapidly changing environment.



The systematic development and preparation of multiple new academic programmes underscore Can Tho University's long-term vision and strong commitment to innovation in higher education. These initiatives not only diversify academic offerings and enhance the quality of human resources but also clearly reflect the University's strategic orientation toward integrating education, research, and knowledge transfer with real societal needs.

This serves as a solid foundation for Can Tho University to further strengthen its role as a leading center for education and scientific research in the Mekong Delta, making substantive contributions to Vietnam's sustainable development in the new era.

- One Consolation Prize at the ICPC National Round
- Two Consolation Prizes at the OlpAI'25 Final Round
- One Consolation Prize in the Open Source Software Category



The Vietnam Student Informatics Olympiad Week, together with the Vietnam Student Artificial Intelligence Olympiad and the ICPC Asia Ho Chi Minh City Regional Contest, concluded in a vibrant and dynamic atmosphere, bringing together talented students with a strong passion for technology from across the country. As the largest academic and technological platform of the year, the event played a significant role in promoting creativity, inspiring aspirations for knowledge exploration, and fostering the robust development of information technology and artificial intelligence within the Vietnamese student community.

The achievements attained by Can Tho University students at these prestigious competitions not only reflect their perseverance, creativity, and strong problem-solving skills, but also affirm the quality of training, research orientation, and international integration capacity of the School of Information and Communication Technology, Can Tho University. CASTID 2025 opened with impressive figures and large-scale professional activities, notably inspiring strong confidence, determination, and broad consensus across the political system, the scientific community, educational institutions, businesses, and society regarding a development pathway driven by science, technology, innovation, and digital transformation. On December 4, 2025, to strengthen connectivity and enhance effective cooperation among government agencies, academic institutions, and the business communities of Vietnam and Japan, Can Tho University partnered with the People’s Committee of Can Tho City, JICA Vietnam, AEON Vietnam Co., Ltd., and Takesho Vietnam Co., Ltd. to convene the Vietnam - Japan Business Networking Forum under the theme “Unlocking the Commodity Potential of the Mekong Delta.”

The Vietnam - Japan Business Networking Forum served not only as a platform for dialogue among government agencies, academic institutions, and enterprises from both countries, but also as a strategic bridge for building a co-creation ecosystem linking academia, industry, and local authorities.

On December 16, 2025, Can Tho University, in coordination with the Can Tho City Department of Science and Technology and relevant partners, solemnly held the Opening Ceremony of the 2025 Can Tho City Science, Technology, Innovation and Digital Transformation Week (CASTID 2025). This marked the largest science, technology, and innovation event ever organized in the Mekong Delta, attracting a wide range of policymakers, scientists, businesses, experts, and startup communities from both Vietnam and abroad. CASTID 2025 took place from December 16 to 20, 2025, featuring more than 20 in-depth professional activities, over 50 exhibition and technology demonstration booths, and the introduction of more than 500 representative technological products, solutions, and innovation models. The event was expected to attract over 10,000 visitors and spanned a wide range of key fields, including artificial intelligence (AI), financial technology (Fintech), smart agriculture, green technologies, digital transformation, and innovation for sustainable development. The Week’s activities were closely aligned with the effective implementation of Resolution No. 57-NQ/TW dated December 22, 2024, of the Politburo on breakthroughs in science, technology, innovation, and national digital transformation, thereby fostering new breakthroughs, unlocking new knowledge, and connecting strategic resources to serve the sustainable development of Can Tho City in the nation’s new era of advancement.

The 12th Quarterly SDMD Dialogue 2025: “Breakthroughs in Science and Technology Development, Innovation, and National Digital Transformation in the New Era”



Within the framework of the Sustainable Development Forum for the Mekong Delta - Outlook 2045 (SDMD 2045), Can Tho University has taken the lead, in coordination with domestic and international partners, in organizing a series of quarterly online SDMD dialogues. Since 2022, eleven SDMD Dialogues have been successfully held, focusing on key issues of the Mekong Delta such as climate change, growth model transformation, science and technology, innovation, and human resource development. These dialogues have served as an important platform connecting policymakers, scientists, experts, businesses, and the community to share knowledge and experience, while promoting cooperation in research, application, and sustainable development across the Mekong Delta region.

Building on the positive outcomes of previous dialogues, on the morning of December 19, 2025, Can Tho University organized the 12th Quarterly SDMD Dialogue in a hybrid format under the theme “Breakthroughs in Science and Technology Development, Innovation, and National Digital Transformation in the New Era.” The event was held in person at the Can Tho University’s Administration Building and livestreamed via the SDMD 2045 Fanpage (<https://www.facebook.com/sdmd2045>), Can Tho University Fanpage (<https://www.facebook.com/CTUDHCT>), and the Zoom platform. This Dialogue was one of the key activities accompanying other major events during the Can Tho City Week of Science, Technology, Innovation, and Digital Transformation 2025 (CASTID 2025). The Dialogue was organized in the context of Vietnam’s strong nationwide implementation of Resolution No. 57-NQ/TW of the Politburo on breakthroughs in the development of science, technology, innovation, and national digital transformation, and Resolution No. 68-NQ/TW of the Politburo on private economic development. These major policy orientations open new opportunities for breakthrough development in the Mekong Delta - a region of strategic importance to the nation in agriculture, the marine economy, renewable energy, and the digital economy. Through the 12th Quarterly SDMD Dialogue, Can Tho University reaffirmed its role as a knowledge nucleus and strategic connector of the Mekong Delta - bringing together policy thinking, scientific knowledge, enterprise resources, and international cooperation. The discussions not only articulated visions and orientations but also strongly emphasized concrete actions, feasible solutions, and substantive cooperation models closely aligned with the needs of localities and enterprises.


